As of June 30, 2023, The Land Institute's financial outlook persists as secure and strong relative to the size of our organization.

We continue to maintain the cash reserve from the previous fiscal year. Additionally, we have taken a more active approach for managing underlying investments in our cash reserve in 2023 with a new investment strategy that will expand in 2024.

Federal and state funding for the development of perennial grain infrastructure has continued to increase over the past several years, but philanthropic support continues to be the foundation for expanding the scope of our many global programs and projects.




